***Eligibility Requirements***

- Undergraduate women committed to completing a Bachelor's Degree and pursuing a career or graduate work in the **geosciences**, including:
- Geology, environmental/engineering geology, geochemistry, geophysics, hydrogeology or hydrology.
- Sophomore, junior, or senior women enrolled in a university or 2-year college in the states of **Washington or Oregon**.
- Minimum of 3.2 GPA (or equivalent academic achievement).

***Submittal Requirements***

- Name, address, phone number and email (if available).
- One paragraph each describing your (1) financial needs, (2) current resources, and (3) academic achievements.
- One-page essay summarizing your commitment to a career in the geosciences.
- All college transcripts (photocopies and scanned copies accepted).
- 3 letters of reference (via mail or email); provide names, affiliations, phone numbers:
  - 2 people familiar with academic achievement and personal commitment (at least one geoscience faculty member).
  - 1 person familiar with your financial needs (may be a relative).

Applicants will be judged on their potential for professional success, academic achievements, and financial need.

Recipient will be notified by December 31, 2011 with award in early spring 2012.

A second-place \$500 scholarship may be awarded depending upon available funding.

***Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.***
